

AKC Delegate Meetings Sept 12 & 13, 2010

Dog Show Rules Committee



Discussion concerning Veterinarians, Chapter 10. It was suggested that the wording for on site vet is too harsh and the wording concerning the event committee. Veterinarians on call must be willing to be available during the show hours. It was suggested that show chairs let the veterinarians know what is expected of them. Any expense for treatment would be the responsibility of the dog's owner.

Anyone who reports a dog as ill to eliminate it from competition could be found guilty of "conduct prejudicial to the sport" by the event committee for that day.

There was discussion allowing specialties in conjunction an all breed show, with a limit of 100 entries. This would be limited to 3 specialties a day and would not prevent the all breed club from offering the same breeds to be shown. The specialties must be finished before groups start. This will start in January 2011. There was also discussion to allow two all breed shows to be held the same day. That idea was not considered to be very viable. There was a proposal to allow for a 4 to 6 months puppy class. This would be a sanctioned event, with no points. The judge would be an AKC approved judge but not one necessarily approved for the puppies they are judging. There could be points going towards a "Beginner's Title". It would be a good socialization opportunity. Veterinarians have said puppies that age should have had all their shots. Some of the problems noted, such as the fees the club could charge versus the superintendent fees.

Addresses of dog's owners in catalogs was discussed again. Although most delegates were under the impression it was up to the club to decide whether to put in contact information, it was noted that it is not possible to do at this time due to changes in programming by the superintendents. The committee voted to leave it as is for the time being.

It was approved by the committee to allow clubs to submit both the show approval and judging panel approval by 18 weeks prior to closing date.

There were some discussions concerning juniors. They are considering a new class or award for juniors for those juniors showing a bred by dog. They are also considering an award for reserve to best junior. Both ideas were well received by the committee.

All Breed Committee

There was a lengthy discussion about insurance for clubs. It was recommended that clubs have liability, errors and omissions, and insurance protecting club members and officers. Those sections designated as not part of the show grounds would not be covered by insurance. Carl Ashby reported that entries are down and it is felt that there is a direct correlation from the fact that there are more dog shows but entries are down. There are many ideas that are being considered to turn this around. One interesting fact is the specialty club entries are not dropping. Some of the ideas being considered are: 4 - 6 mo puppy class; reserve BIS; two additional group placements; run the bred by class like Eukanuba; amateur own class and BIS. Matches are felt to do more benefit for the local community and is very helpful in promoting clubs. A breeder of merit program is being organized. This recognition will set the AKC breeder that meets the criteria on a higher plane. (See attached)

It was suggested that the clubs wanting to draw more gate offer some events like fly ball, Frisbee demos, something fun that the public would enjoy. It was also suggested contacting the state to see if it is possible to advertise on the amber alert screens.

AKC Meeting

The forum was presented by the City of Calgary Animal Services & Bylaw Services Director, Bill Bruce. He gave a good presentation of how they take care of animals in Calgary. I have asked him for a copy of his presentation and when I get it I will share it either at a meeting or by email.

During the meeting it was announced that there will be new programs regarding registration options. All the information is on the web site or see attached.

The financial situation with AKC continues to be grim.

We voted on eliminating term limits. The vote was 151 for removal of term limits, 220 to retain the term limits. All the rules changes regarding field trial rules were adopted.

A proposal for a rule change regarding dividing assignments regarding lunch breaks. This will be voted on during the December meeting.
